

Of Every 100 People Infected with HCV



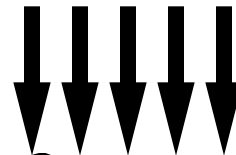
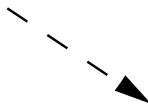
10-15 people appear to beat the HCV
