Sterile Injection

6,822 unique people using drugs assisted with positive change 10,017 exchanges of contaminated syringes for sterile ones 3.39 million sterile syringes exchanged



39,695 people injecting reached by program participants

People Treated

Assisted 316 people to access addiction therapies (methadone/bup) 2,116 people vaccinated for hepatitis A/B, flu and other 5,812 people assisted in accessing medical care, housing, food, clothing, domestic violence protection, and legal assistance, etc

12,844 engaged in safer injection and safer sex efforts

Trained 8 819 people in oniate overdose prevention and eff

Trained 8,819 people in opiate overdose prevention and effective peer intervention with naloxone
